Hope to see you there!

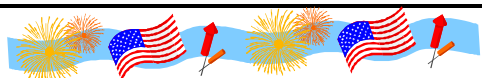

- A sandwich/salad box has been purchased for the kitchen. Efficiency should improve, especially on busy nights.
- Driving range/equipment was discussed. Further resolution and discussion will be had and revisited next month.
- Policy regarding dependent status was reviewed. Currently the bylaws read "Where the regular member is the head of a family, all dependent members of his family shall be entitled to the privileges of the Club until 22 years of age or their dependent status ceases to exist."
- Written Golf Pro, Pool and Entertainment Committee reports were circulated and reviewed.

## 2008 McDonald's KIDS IN MOTION Golf Tournament

The 2008 Kids in Motion Golf Tournament, sponsored by McDonald's and the Hannibal Country Club, is scheduled for Monday, July 21, at HCC. Registration, a silent auction and lunch begin at 11:30 a.m., followed by a 1 p.m. tee off.

The format is a four-person scramble (men, women or any combination) with a maximum of 18 teams. Proceeds go to the Kids in Motion program, which is under the umbrella of Douglass Community Services, Inc.

Kids in Motion is a pre-employment program targeting at-risk kids in Hannibal. Program founder Bob Gilstrap said, "We have helped hundreds of kids during the past dozen summers. I hope everyone will come out and support this event. It will be a lot of fun and will benefit a very worthy program."

There are several participation levels. The fee for a single golfer is \$75, which includes golf, cart, lunch, beverages and gifts. A team foursome is \$300, which has the same benefits as a single golfer. A K.I.M. Help Package can be purchased for \$50, which includes 2 pay it forwards, 25 feet of string and 2 mulligans.

Special features include a \$10,000 hole-in-one opportunity! Golfers can rent a golf pro for a shot, and there will be awards for longest drive and closest to the pin. Prizes will be awarded.

Sponsorships are available and silent auction items needed. Cost to sponsor a hole is \$100.

## HANNIBAL COUNTRY CLUB POOL RULES

Open daily 10 a.m. to 8 p.m.

### POOL

- No glassware in the pool area. This applies to after hours, also.
- Lifeguards are not responsible for answering the phone. Please limit calls as well.
- Lap swimming is available. Ask the guard.
- One person on the diving board at a time. Guard may ask a child to swim the length of the pool to assess their swimming ability.
- No rafts in the deep end. Keep rafts and toys out of pool if not in use. Do not store rafts in restroom.
- Children under 8 must be accompanied by a member 12 years of age or older. Babysitters are available. Check the bulletin board for names.
- There will be a lifeguard break/adult swim at 10 minutes before the hour.
- Private parties are permitted after hours, but not on Friday night or if club event is planned. Friday night will continue to be family night and is open to all families. Contact Club Manager to schedule a party.
- Family pool carry-in events are authorized on Friday nights during the months the pool is open. On Friday evenings, families may bring carry-in food items (pool and adjacent area only). Alcohol must be purchased from the club/restaurant.

### GUESTS

- Please register guests with the lifeguard. A one-time fee of \$5 will be charged for out-of-town guests during the summer. Out-of-town guests must live at least 18 miles from Hannibal.
- In-town guest rules: No more than two in-town guests per day, per family member. No person can be a guest more than two times during the summer. Please check that your guest hasn't already been a guest of other club members. Lifeguards keep a record of all guests. A fee of \$2 per guest, per visit for in-town guests.

### POOLSIDE CAFÉ: CONCESSION STAND

- Hours: 11 a.m. to 7 p.m. daily. If the pool closes and then reopens, the Poolside Café will reopen at the discretion of the Manager.
- The Poolside Café will be open on Mondays with limited food selection available.
- The Poolside Café will offer beverages and prepackaged food (candy, chips, ice cream, pretzels and nachos). You may also order from the club pool menu, which includes many items prepared in the club kitchen. The Poolside Café will take your order as well as pick up the order for items ordered from the pool menu only. Avoid ordering during the noon rush hour to decrease your wait time. All transactions will be billed to your account. Members can pick up a copy of their ticket from the concession server, if desired.

A clean pool is appreciated by all. Please use trash cans and clean off tables when you are finished.
